2 Background

- 2.1 The Health, Housing & Public Conveniences Team is one of six teams within the Environmental Health Service. The responsibilities of the team are diverse in nature and include regulation and enforcement, advice, promotion of health and wellbeing and management of the public conveniences across the district.
- 2.2 Much of the work carried out by the team links very closely with the draft Strategic Growth Plan for the Council area, particularly in relation to the social pillar and particularly the Health & Wellbeing strand.

3 Key Issues

- 3.1 The service plan outlines an ambitious programme of work for the 2017-18 year and members' views or comments are welcome in relation to the plan presented.
- 3.2 Some of the services delivered by the team are reliant on government funding, particularly those in relation to Affordable Warmth, Home Safety and Tobacco Control and some uncertainty exists in relation to funding for the 2017-18 year.

- 4.1 The plan includes the review of public conveniences across the district. The outcome of the review and any recommendations will be brought before committee in due course.
