1 Purpose of Report/Recommendations

- 1.1 To update Members on works to repair Council properties following the flooding incident of August 2017.

2 Background

- 2.1 Members will recall previous item ER248/17 setting out the properties damaged during the flooding and the costs associated with making good the damage caused.
- 2.2 Council has committed to repairing all of the damaged facilities. Officers have recommended that this is carried out on a phased basis depending on the nature of the facility, its use and on any future plans for the redevelopment of the site. The total estimated cost of full report to all 26 Council premises in the region of £1.5 million.
- 2.3 Following discussion and agreement at the previous E&R meeting works will commence immediately to the following facilities subject of course to the normal procurement obligations.

Location	Works Required
Claudy Country Park	Repairs to walkways and boundry wall
Drumnaspar Picnic Area	Replace damaged fencing and furniture

Dunverne Gardens	Replace damaged fencing
Learmount Forest	Repairs to forest paths
Plumbridge Toilets	Repairs to steps and fencing
Plunbridge Walkway / Market	Repairs to fencing
Strabane Riverside Walkway / Meeting House Street	Repairs to walkways, repair gabions on river bank
Tullyalley Community Centre	Repairs to community centre
Newtonstewart Recycling Centre	Repairs to buildings, equipment

3 Key Issues

- 3.1 These repairs as advised within the previous item are considered in the category 'smaller works' and can be progressed immediately.
- 3.2 Officers will bring a further update to Members in due course with regard to the other facilities damaged during the flooding.

4.1 The costs of these repairs will be funded directly from in year capital savings as agreed with the Lead Finance Officer.
