1 Purpose of Report/Recommendations

- 1.1 To inform Members of the outcome of recent applications to provide bilingual signage at Glenfada Park, Harding Street, Lisfannon Park, Thistlewood Park and Westland Street, Derry.

 - Thistlewood Park
 - Westland Street

3 Key issues

- 3.1 In accordance with Council policy on Street Naming and Postal Numbering, 2.4.1.2, Council has undertaken a plebiscite in these streets and the following results were obtained:

Street/Road	Number of plebiscites returned	% of those who responded who wanted bilingual signage	% of those who responded who did not want bilingual signage
Glenfada Park	23	100%	0%
Harding Street	25	64%	36%
Lisfannon Park	37	95%	5%
Thistlewood Park	27	78%	22%
Westland Street	31	94%	6%

5 Recommendations

5.1 In accordance with Derry City and Strabane District Council's Policy on Street Naming and Property Numbering, the plebiscites achieved the minimum consent of 66% of returns required to place bilingual signage at Glenfada Park, Lisfannon Park, Thistlewood Park and Westland Street, Derry.

5.2 The plebiscite did not achieve the minimum consent of 66% of returns required to place bilingual signage at Harding Street, Derry
